INFA Committee Candidate Requirements:

Education Committee

1. Graduate of a nurse anesthesia education program, masters degree preferred.
2. Experience teaching anesthesia students in the classroom and clinical area.
3. Knowledge of IFNA's Anesthesia Program Approval Process.
4. Ideally experience in reviewing anesthesia schools/programs for an organization that evaluates the quality of education offered.
5. Resident of a country that is an IFNA member.
6. Attendance at professional meetings related to education or participates in other forms of continuing education.
7. Be recognized in the local, regional or national area of residence as a leader in education.
8. Familiar with IFNA's Standards of Education, Practice, Monitoring and Code of Ethics.
9. The candidate has to be supported by the country member association.
10. The candidate has English language skills at a level necessary for reviewing and writing committee documents.
11. A fair geographical representation shall be taken in consideration.
12. The candidate shall be available for attending required IFNA meetings.

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Practice

Candidates for IFNA's Practice Committee ideally meet the following requirements:

1. Graduate of a nurse anesthesia education program.
2. Academic skills on a masters level preferably.
3. Nurse anesthesia practice experience of at least 10 years and current part time practice.
4. Resident of a country that is an IFNA member.
5. Be recognized in the local, regional or national area of residence as a leader in nurse anesthesia professional affairs and supported by the national member association.



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6. Administrative, research, and/or organizational knowledge in nurse anesthesia practice.
7. Knowledge and interest in nurse anesthesia resources globally.
8. Knowledge and expertise in Continuous Professional Development (CPD).
9. Familiar with IFNA's Standards of Education, Practice, Monitoring and Code of Ethics with Ability to offer revisions according to evidenced based practice and current trends in practice.
10. The candidate has English language skills necessary for reviewing and writing committee documents.
11. A fair geographical representation shall be taken in consideration.
12. The candidate shall be available for attending required IFNA meetings
